The Courts - We have two tarmacadam courts, which were re-painted in 2007. In order to maintain the current high standard of the courts, members are asked to wear appropriate footwear and only bring tennis equipment on to the courts.

Access to the courts for members is via the clubhouse gates. The padlocks are a combination type and the number is given out with annual membership card (same number for both locks). Please ensure the lock is closed properly when leaving and the numbered dials rotated. The other gate is for public access only.

The Clubhouse - We have one brick built clubhouse, located next to the courts. The facilities currently comprise a clubroom incorporating a kitchenette, storage for club equipment and a unisex toilet.

There are a number of notice boards, both externally and in the clubhouse, which display information on tournaments, LTA notices, club event photos, tennis magazines, the club rules, members contact details and additional membership forms. A selection of tennis balls is also available.

Access to the clubhouse is via the right hand door. Senior members can obtain keys for this door from the chairman on request.

Adult Members – There is club play, where all adult (and Intermediate) members can participate on a Sunday morning between 10 and 12 o'clock; on Wednesday afternoon between 6 to 8 o'clock; and on Thursday mornings 10 to 12 o'clock (Rusty racquets). Both courts are available widely outside these times for members to make their own arrangements, but please note a guest fee is payable by non-members.

Junior and Intermediate members – There are 10 free coaching sessions for Juniors and 4 for Intermediates on a Saturday afternoon each year. A number of friendly and league games with other teams take place during the summer. And a club championship is contested between July and September. Please contact Julia Kirkland for details

Membership Cards - These are issued from May of each year. You should always have your card with you when playing at the club. Preference for court access is given to the various member types, a list of which can be found on court and clubhouse notice boards. You may also receive discounts at sports shops, when purchasing tennis items, on producing your card.

Coaching – A club coach is available for both seniors, Intermediates and juniors. Our coach is Justin Cook and his team, who are very active with our Junior and Intermediate sections on Saturday afternoons, most of whose coaching is free of charge! Newsletters - There are regular newsletters written to keep the membership informed of club activities. They are delivered by post or via email and are available on our web site.

Tournaments - The club runs Senior American tournaments from May to September (see website for dates); the Junior section is particularly active and Julia and Justin are organising this year's events. We do also enter teams into various local leagues where there is a demand. Please contact a committee member if you would like to take part or would like more information.
